EMERGENCY GATHERING IN IOWA CITY

On Tuesday, January 15th, we will gather in Iowa City to decry the unjust, totalitarian actions being taken against Donna Holman.

HISTORY OF THE SITUATION: In March, 2007, Donna Holman, a 72 year-old grandmother, was convicted of a bogus charge of "Harassment." Donna was arrested November 1, 2006 during a normal sidewalk counseling situation at Planned Parenthood in Iowa City, Iowa. Though video of the purported altercation showed no harassment, Judge Karen Egerton found Donna Holman guilty on the hearsay testimony of Planned Parenthood employees. The charges were an apparent setup between Planned Parenthood and Iowa City Police. Two female officers were poised to arrest Donna Holman at Planned Parenthood as the first abortion appointment arrived.

The "victim" whom Mrs. Holman purportedly harassed was subpoenaed but did not show up for court. The courtroom audience was packed with Planned Parenthood executive types. Karen Egerton accepted the hearsay testimony of Planned Parenthood employees in lieu of the "victims" testimony. She rejected defendant's video evidence which showed no harassment took place. Judge Egerton has also ordered Donna Holman to see a psychiatrist and demands that she take any psychiatric medication the shrink recommends.

Donna Holman is a sane, faithful pro-lifer who ministered at the PP deathcamp regularly. We will not sit by while she is railroaded by the thugs who rule Iowa City at the behest of Planned Parenthood.

WHY I WILL VOTE FOR RON PAUL

Do we want lip-service or do we want to dismantle the federal infrastructure?

Many have falsely claimed that presidential candidate Ron Paul would not support the Human Life Amendment because he simply wants to return the abortion question to the states. One lady even told me “if Paul is president and a law is passed at the federal level to outlaw abortion, he won’t sign it.” Oh, yeah, like that’s a real concern. Let’s see, the Republicans had the House, the Senate, and the Presidency for six years and how many laws were passed and sent to the President to outlaw abortion? Umm-hmm. None.

Let’s set the facts straight on this matter. First, Ron Paul is 100% pro-life. Second in his book *Abortion and Liberty*, Dr. Paul makes clear that he supports the Human Life Amendment. Third, it is important to understand how the process of an amendment to the Constitution actually works. *Three-fourths of the state legislatures in America have to vote in support of it!* In other words, even if you have Congress pass a federal amendment outlawing abortion, the “abortion question” *is still going back to the states before it can be ratified!*

Do you think that three-fourths of our nation’s state legislatures will ratify the amendment? I can assure you they won’t. Hence, Ron Paul supports and encourages states to enact laws outlawing abortion. This is why he introduced in 2007 his *We The People Act* (HR 300) which would prohibit the federal courts from making rulings that would reverse laws against abortion which are enacted by state legislatures. That’s right, Ron Paul’s *We The People Act* (HR 300) would prohibit the federal courts from acting on or reversing laws against abortion which are enacted by state legislatures.

Understand this also, if there is a sheriff, or district attorney, or state’s attorney general, or governor, who takes a stand against the federal tyranny of *Roe v. Wade* (the lesser-magistrate doctrine in action), I can guarantee Ron Paul would be the *only* president that would NOT send in federal agents to force the lesser magistrate back into compliance. I can assure you all the other presidential candidates *would* send in federal agents in a heartbeat to punish the lesser magistrate for resisting federal tyranny (all done of course under the phony “it’s the law of the land” argument) so that the killing of the preborn could continue.

When it comes to sodomy, all of the presidential candidates including Ron Paul and Mike Huckabee have made comments about homosexuality which are pathetic. Many Christians demagogue the fact that Ron Paul did not vote for the Marriage Protection Amendment (MPA). Frankly, I would not have voted for it either because it still would have allowed civil unions for homosexuals. The only difference between “marriage” and “civil unions” is semantics; in essence they are the exact same thing. Therefore even many pro-family groups opposed the amendment or remained neutral.

The MPA even in its weakened wording did not come close to passing. What do you think the chances an amendment with actual bite to it has of passing when it comes to the unscrupulous people who inhabit Washington, D.C.? Why are we looking to the federal government to undo the tyranny of immorality which the federal government itself continues to force upon the American people? When will we realize that our federal government, which has brought us the immoral tyranny that our nation suffers under, is not the answer to undo the immoral tyranny? *(over)*

I can live with Paul's pathetic comments more than the other candidates because his *We The People Act* (HR 300) would *also prohibit* federal courts from undoing laws against sodomy and same-sex marriage which are enacted by state legislatures. In other words, they could not do to us what they did in regards to abortion (*Roe v. Wade*) by shoving immorality down our throats through raw judicial tyranny.

And again be assured of this, if there were a federal judicial ruling that demanded states recognize same-sex marriage, Ron Paul would be the *only* president that would NOT send in federal agents to force compliance if there were a lesser magistrate who took a stand against such an unjust ruling. All the other candidates *would* send in federal agents to force compliance.

I would also note that Paul would veto any Hate Crimes legislation, as he has consistently voted against Hate Crimes while a congressman. Not only that, but he would not allow any funding for pro-homosexual efforts (as is done now) to come from the federal government. In fact, he would dismantle the Federal Reserve, the Department of Education, and host of other unnecessary, unconstitutional federal agencies and practices. This is important because much of the existing federal infrastructure helps keep baby-murder, the homosexual agenda, and many other evils, intact and funded.

I am convinced that a presidency of any of the other Republican candidates would give us mere lip-service in regards to the matters which are important to us as Christians. I've stomached this lip-service from the Republicans for 30 years now. I smell it all over the other candidates, including Huckabee. Therefore I've decided not to sit by silently and watch this repugnant kettle of fish simmer without speaking up and throwing in my two-cents. Lip-service might suffice for those who've just recently acquainted themselves with politics, but for me it is a stench I abhor.

Lip-service might be nice if you have no alternative, but in this situation we do. A Ron Paul presidency would end the status quo. It would bring huge change. It would level the playing field. Why? Because he will veto 95% of what Congress sends to him. He will begin to dismantle the federal infrastructure. He will defund a federal government gone mad. Individual states would no longer be mere bureaucratic conduits of the federal government. Take time to read about President John Tyler (1841-1845). He vetoed nearly everything Congress sent to him, and he opposed the establishment of a central bank. His life is an interesting read. It is the type of presidency we need today, and the type Ron Paul would deliver to us.

Urgent: Pro-Life Physicians to be made into criminals in Wisconsin!

Due to the preliminary passage of **Assembly Bill 377**, the Chemical Abortion Hospital Mandate law, it has come to our attention that the State Medical Examining Board has put together new policies *to penalize pro-life physicians* who refuse to comply with the killing of the preborn! This proves yet again, that there is no neutrality. Someone's law and worldview will rule, and when it is the wicked's law, those who stand for righteousness will be criminalized and penalized. Now a physician who simply refuses to comply with being a part of an abortion will put his license to practice medicine in jeopardy.

This bill mandates that *any and all* hospitals *must* provide chemical abortifacients to a woman who claims to be the victim of rape or incest. Planned Parenthood and NARAL pushed the bill forward. It is important to note that Wisconsin Right to Life did NOT oppose this legislation. Why?? Because this law only applies to those conceived in rape or incest, and National Right to Life believes in exception clauses for rape and incest.
