There was no small stir in the Milwaukee area during the anniversary of the infamous Roe v. Wade decision this year. A local pro-life group mailed out fetal models of an eleven week old preborn baby to hundreds of homes in the city of Racine. The press jumped all over this story as people were “offended” by this action which “crossed the line.”

The news story below (one of many) reveals the fact that what offends people is *not* the graphic photographs we use to expose the atrocities being committed against the preborn, but the simple truth that preborn babies are human beings. *They are offended because they do not want to be reminded that abortion is the killing of a person.* Whether you use a graphic photograph or an innocuous little plastic fetal model, they are still offended.

Notice the story says that the woman offended was reminded “*of the graphic placards she seen pro-life demonstrators display in parts of the city in the past.*” This shows the searing power the photographs we display have on the minds of those who see them.

Pro-life mailing offends some residents

RACINE — Peggy Bell recycled the tiny plastic fetus she received in the mail. She didn't know what else to do with it. Bell, 51, an insurance agent, wasn't going to spend the money to send it back to the local Wisconsin Right to Life chapter, the organization that sent it to her, she said.

Bell and several of her neighbors in the 5300 block of 16th Street received the plastic statue this week, along with literature from the pro-life organization.

The pro-life literature that comes in the mail from time to time doesn't bother Bell, who said she believes abortion is “a very personal and individual decision,” but the plastic fetus statue somehow crossed a line, she said. It reminded her of the graphic placards she seen pro-life demonstrators display in parts of the city in the past.

“I don't care what literature you send me, but I just think they went too far,” said Bell, who sent a letter to the local chapter to tell them how she felt. “I was offended. I think it was in poor taste.”

The manila mailer addressed to “Resident” seemed innocent enough to those who found it in their mailboxes Tuesday, but the neighbors agreed the contents surprised them.

The Racine Chapter of Wisconsin Right to Life sent the mailing to mark the Jan. 22nd anniversary of the passage of Roe v. Wade, the Supreme Court ruling 35 years ago that struck down many state laws restricting abortion.

The roughly 2-inch fetus, called the “Young One,” is a model of a “pre-born.” The model, which fits in the palm of a hand, included a card detailing the development of an 11- to 12-week-old “pre-born.”

“We are sending the ‘Young One’ model to all of the residents in Racine to help remind them of the humanity of the unborn baby,” the letter accompanying the model stated. “We hope that you use the model to involve your family and friends in the discussion of human development.”

DONNA HOLMAN RELEASED FROM JAIL!

In our last mailing, we told you of an emergency gathering we were conducting in Iowa on behalf of Donna Holman who was being persecuted by the governing authorities who are acting in complicity with Planned Parenthood officials.

About 45 of us made it to Iowa City to stand with her and against the injustice she was suffering. At Donna's hearing, the judge threw her in jail for 30 days. Watching the whole debacle was very grievous. We encouraged Donna as deputies escorted her from the courtroom.

Afterward, we tasted the corruptness of the town ourselves as three people from our group were ordered to appear in court for blocking a public sidewalk. They were simply picketing (as we all were) when police came and accosted them. The charges are bogus. The message is clear. *"Don't come back or we'll harass you more."*

After demonstrating at the courthouse both before and after Donna's hearing, we spent the rest of the day at various busy intersections speaking up for the preborn with our photographs and literature.

72 year-old Donna Holman refused to comply with being strip-searched, so the jailers put her in a cold cell with no blanket for her first night. They relented the next morning however, and even let her have her bible. She was released on St. Valentine's Day, February 14th.

THE HORSE AND PONY SHOW

As predictable as the sun coming up tomorrow, every so often there is an attempt to repeal Wisconsin's anti-abortion statute 940.04. This attempt is perennial as some grasses. Forgive me for sounding so cynical, but this is nothing more than a horse and pony show which brings in lots of money for Wisconsin Right to Life on the pro-life side and Planned Parenthood of Wisconsin on the pro-abortion side. Both sides know that there's not a snowballs chance in hell of the law being repealed, but they both get to send out their hysterical alerts and alarms which fills their coffers from their faithful followers.

What I find interesting about this go-around however, is that while Planned Parenthood and NARAL are screaming about the fact that 940.04 criminalizes women who have abortions, Wisconsin Right to Life responds by pointing out that in 1985 they led the charge to remove any penalties for women involved in abortion by passing a law (940.13) which removed any punishment for women who hire assassins to murder their own sons or daughters.

I find this interesting. Why would we criminalize abortion, even call it murder - a capital crime - and then have no punishment for the women who do it? This position held by pro-lifers is faulty for three reasons: First, it is an affront to God's Law; second, it insults justice; and third, it spits upon the humanity of the preborn child.

Man is made in God's image and therefore must be protected by civil law. Murder is a violation of God's Law (Ex.20:13). God's Law is clear that murderers should be punished (Ex.21:12). God's Law also states that if two men are in the commission of a fight, and one strikes a woman who is pregnant and the woman or the baby dies, the man is to be punished (Ex. 21:22-25). How much more is the punishment just if the baby is killed deliberately by the woman and the abortionist? Allowing murder to go unpunished is an affront to God's Law.

Justice is ridiculed by this position of no punishment. Black's Law Dictionary (and all dictionaries) make clear that if you declare something to be criminal, punishment is assumed. The idea of calling abortion the capital crime of murder and then saying there should be no punishment is moral schizophrenia and an insult to the very nature of justice.

I remember when I was young hearing a *Right to Life* leader say that abortionists should only be fined the first time they are caught committing an abortion and that women should receive no punishment at all. That left me thinking – *so what's the big deal about abortion?* If those who are opposed to abortion think the penalty should be a fine and nothing at all, surely the killing of the preborn cannot be that big of a thing. They were spitting on the humanity of the preborn by suggesting such measly punishments for murder.

Is abortion just 'not a good thing to do' or is it a crime? Is the preborn child a person or not? By the way, there is a trend all around the country. Every time pro-life legislators introduce a personhood amendment for their state constitution, National Right to Life or their state affiliate take a neutral position publicly, and then they quietly work behind the scenes to oppose it. Why not ask Wisconsin Right to Life to introduce a personhood amendment for our State Constitution? Let's see what they say and how they act.
